

Promoting networking with the School of Tourism at Bournemouth University

Raquel Santos-Lacueva, PhD Fellow at the Research Group on Territorial Analysis and Tourism Studies (GRATET), has joined recently the International Centre for Tourism and Hospitality Research at Bournemouth University (UK) as visiting PhD researcher. During her 3-month stay, she is going to collaborate directly with internationally-renowned Professor Stephen Page.

Her thesis is focused on the vulnerability of coastal destinations in front of climate change by means of analyzing tourism policies – i.e. adaptation and mitigation strategies. The main purpose of her stay is to improve the theoretical and methodological foundations of her thesis by opening up the exchange of ideas and discussions with Prof. Page. This is also expected to promote active networking between the GRATET and the BU research groups.

The stay is funded by the Spanish Ministry of Economy and Competitiveness and it is developed under the umbrella of the GLOBALTUR project.
